"From the East Alligator River on the border of Kakadu National Park, the drive to the Arnhemland Barramundi Nature Lodge is approximately 280 km. Accessible only by permit, Arnhemland is far and away the largest Aboriginal reserve in Australia. It is spectacular country, a kaleidoscope of diverse habitat and terrain, and a wilderness refuge for a menagerie of tropical Australian wildlife. Whether fording valley streams, rich in hue and clarity, and still pulsing with the residue of the last big Wet, or trailing a plumed tail of golden bulldust over dried, powdery tracks, on some days not another vehicle will be sighted. Much of Arnhemland is Stone Country, and this became even more evident in May 2006 when Cyclone Monica exploded down the middle of this mythical, ancient land, thus revealing rugged, vividly-hued escarpments that previously were not visible from the Maningrida Track."
